A 70-year-old man developed a perineal abscess with an impacted stone. After placement of a rectal stent under local anesthesia, an anaerobic culture of a pus specimen from the abscess and an abdominoperineal resection of the rectum confirmed acute perineal abscess. The patient's symptoms resolved completely after 4 months. The duration of the stent ranged from 3 to 20 months. There were no complications, and the patient was fully satisfied with the stent. A: As a matter of fact, the links do work. I just tested it myself. However, most modern browsers block third party cookies so that users are not exposed to potentially malicious cookies. Therefore you have to disable third party cookies on the browser you're using. Q: How to "close" an Excel cell in a conditional formatting formula? I am trying to create a conditional format to highlight a cell if it has a certain number or range of numbers in it, e.g. Cell 1 contains the numbers 1 to 5 and I want to make

the cell green if it contains 1 to 4. Unfortunately the conditional formatting formula does not "close" the cell if it returns an invalid number, e.g. if it returns 9 it will highlight a cell containing the number 1 to 9 as red. I know that if I just put =0 in the formula it will work fine, but the same cell will be highlighted if the cell is left empty or if it contains text. Anyone have any idea why? A: The issues with the formula is because it considers the text in the cell also. The result 9 will be highlighted because it evaluates to 9 in the IF. The IF should be more along the lines of: =OR(NOT(ISERROR(MID(A1,2,1))), ISERROR(MID(A1,2,1))) This looks for the number in the first part, and if it is a number returns TRUE, if it isn't it will return a FALSE, and the result of that is then returned, which is the result of the OR statement. You could also change this to =IF(AND(NOT(ISERROR(MID(A1,2,1))), ISERROR(MID(A1,2,1))), TRUE, FALSE). This would look for either part to be a number, and if both are numbers return TRUE, if either are not it will return FALSE. This would therefore return a TRUE/FALSE result, which can then be used in the conditional formatting.
